Set up your account, choose your language and then you are inside an application which probably looks like an internet site to you. How right you are. At "Events" enter "go" and you will receive a list of all the golf majors since their beginning and be able to browse them. Or at "Athletes" and "Name" put in "jor" and you should find Michael Jordan. Click on the "Details" button and a list of his achievements etc. will appear.

Pretty regular internet stuff but fast, or what?

In fact you are talking to SmartWare databases in an SPL application which was in fact set up under version 1.51 in 1992!. It is now running under an advanced version of SmartWare GT.

Incidentally, Sportdb is the only database of its kind on the web and growing in popularity, although it has only been running in a test environment since July and open since the end of September and under its own domain name since mid-October 2000.

Having seen the results live, more and more clients in Europe are rushing to have their applications put up on the web or made intranet capable. If we have inspired you with our introduction in Sportdb then let us know what your

application is like and we will quote you a complete price to make it go on the web.

Let's just stop and review the possibilities.

Any multi-user SmartWare application can be made to run on the web and an intranet. It is spoken to from clients running commercial browsers like Netscape or Internet Explorer etc. The application you looked at in Sportdb is a live environment actively run as a commercial operation and driven by SmartWare dbs and SPL. The appearance is fully "web-like" and the speed is amazing. You could expand your application on to the web or even look at ASP (Application Service Provider) opportunities. All the techy wonders that you know from the web are possible within the limits of browser technology. As we have SPL behind all this many workarounds can effectively expand the limits of browser technology.
